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III Attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, do hereby certify that:

- 1. African Swine Fever (ASF) and Classical Swine Fever (CSF) are notifiable diseases in Finland;
- 2. Finland has been free from Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) without vaccination and CSF three months immediately prior to the date of slaughter and date of export. The FMD free status without vaccination is officially recognised by the WOAH;
- 3. Finland or the zone of origin has been free from ASF in domestic pigs immediately prior to the date of slaughter and the date of export in line with the following conditions:
 - a. in the event of an ASF outbreak in domestic pigs: pork and pork products exported to Singapore are not derived from restricted zone III listed in the latest updated Annex of the EU Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/605. This includes pork and pork products derived from swine in farms located in areas listed as restricted zone III and from slaughterhouses located in areas listed as restricted zone III;
 - b. in the event of an ASF outbreak in wild pigs: in line with WOAH guidelines, export of pork and pork products to Singapore can continue; and
 - c. by way of derogation, the prohibitions in point a. does not apply to heat-treated products processed in accordance with WOAH guidelines;
- 4. Finland is recognised by the WOAH as having negligible BSE risk status;
- 5. the products have not been derived from animals which have been swill-fed;
- 6. traceability of animals through a reliable system is in place;
- 7. the products have not been derived from suspect or confirmed BSE cases, or suspect of confirmed progeny or cohorts of BSE cases, as described in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code;
- 8. the products have been derived from cattle that were not subjected to a stunning process with a device injecting compressed air or gas into the cranial cavity, or to a pithing process;
- 9. specified risk materials⁽¹⁾ have been cleanly removed from products for export to Singapore without contamination of the meat;
- 10. the products do not contain mechanically separated/recovered meat;
- 11. the products have been derived from animals born and bred in Finland;
- 12. the meat has been derived from animals which have passed ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection and found to be free from infectious and contagious diseases. Ante-mortem and post-mortem inspections have been carried out by veterinarians or meat inspectors under direct supervision of government veterinarians;
- 13. the meat has been derived from animals which were slaughtered, processed, packed and stored under sanitary conditions under official veterinary supervision in establishments approved by the Director-General, Food Administration for export to Singapore;
- 14. the meat has not been treated with chemical preservatives or other substances injurious to health;
- 15. the meat has been inspected and found fit for human consumption and every precaution must be taken to prevent contamination prior to export; and
- 16. retort processed meat products (e.g. canned meat) have been heat treated (sterilising process with sterilising value of not less than Fo3) to commercial sterility in hermetically sealed containers and are shelf stable at ambient temperatures.

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

⁽¹⁾ Specified risk materials refer to brain, eye, spinal cord, skull and vertebral column from cattle 30 months and older, and the distal ileum and tonsils from all cattle.
