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III Attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, do hereby certify that:

1. infection with high pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in Finland;
2. country has been free from HPAI for the past twelve (12) months prior to export or the past 28 days following a stamping out policy in accordance with WOAHP Terrestrial Animal Health Code;
OR
the eggs were not derived from birds originating from areas within the 10 km surveillance zone(s) established around a HPAI-affected farm;
3. the eggs come from animals, which were born and reared in _____, an EU Member State, approved for export of eggs to Singapore;
4. the eggs are unfertilized and derived from layer flocks kept in a farm accredited for the import of eggs by SFA;
5. the farm where the eggs originate has been tested and found to be free from Salmonella Enteritidis, and no case of velogenic Newcastle disease has been diagnosed on the farm for the last three (3) months prior to export;
6. the eggs have a fully developed shell and are clean, fresh and fit for human consumption;
7. additives and/or colouring matters injurious to health have not been added;
8. the eggs have been handled and packed in appropriately sanitised packaging materials and containers in a hygienic manner; and
9. the eggs are labelled with a unique identifier code, issued by the competent authority of Finland or SFA, to identify the producing farm.
