IV Attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, do hereby certify that:

1. the casings described above were derived from animals born and raised in Finland or in another European Union Member State;
2. the casings were derived from animals sent to slaughter from a region which according to the WOAHA Terrestrial Animal Health Code was free from the following diseases: Foot-and-mouth disease, Rinderpest, African swine fever and Classical swine fever;
3. the casings were derived from animals that were slaughtered at an approved slaughterhouse in accordance with the European Union and national legislation under the supervision of the competent authority of the country of origin. The animals were subjected to ante- and post-mortem inspection according to the conditions laid down in the relevant European Union and national legislation and were found free from any signs of contagious diseases;
4. the casings were manufactured at (an) establishment(s) and stored at (a) storage(s) that have been approved and that are under the supervision of the competent authority;
5. the casings were handled, produced, packed and stored under sanitary conditions in accordance with the European Union and national legislation on public health requirements; and
6. the casings are considered safe and suitable for human consumption or for production of food for human consumption.
