


European Food Safety Authority (EFSA)

The reference body for risk assessment of food and feed in the European Union. Its work covers the entire food chain – from field to fork





EFSA Risk Assessments - Scientific opinions











Provides independent scientific advice and support for EU risk managers and policy makers on food and feed safety



Provides independent, timely risk communication



Promotes scientific cooperation





Develop food safety policies & legislation




Adopt regulations, authorise marketing of new products

EFSA procurement

- When EFSA needs to buy services or supplies
- Call for tenders
 - Open calls (≥140 000 €)
 - Negotiated procedures (15 000–140 000 €)
 - Call => expression of interest => invitation to submit a tender
 - In duly justified circumstances, "monopoly" negotiated procedures
- Direct contract: Fixed duration and fixed price
- Framework contract: A price list is established for services over max 4 years and orders will be placed when the services are required



EFSA grants

- Projects and activities that contribute to EFSA's mission; data collection,
 preparatory work for scientific opinions, other scientific and technical assistance
- Call for proposals
 - Calls open to art. 36 organisations (any value)
 - In duly justified circumstances, "monopoly" negotiated procedure
- Direct agreement: Fixed duration and fixed max financing
- **Framework partnership agreement**: Duration ≤4 years, specific agreements are signed on the topics foreseen in the agreement



Article 36 competent organisations

- EFSA grants can only be awarded to competent organisations designated by Member States (Article 36 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002).
- Currently 323 organisations included on the <u>list of article 36 organisations</u>.
- Organisations active in fields of EFSA's mission, including universities, research institutes, other governmental or public bodies.
- Organisations from EU Member States + Norway and Iceland
- Suomen Art. 36 organisaatiot: Helsingin yliopisto, Luonnonvarakeskus, Ruokavirasto, Suomen ympäristökeskus, Terveyden ja hyvinvoinnin laitos, Turun yliopisto ja Turvallisuus- ja kemikaalivirasto.

CONTRACT TYPE

DIRECT CONTRACT

- You know exactly what you need, when, how much;
- Full financial commitment required at contract signature

FRAMEWORK CONTRACT

- You know what you need in coming years, but not timing or quantity;
- No financial commitment required at contract signature

Who can apply?

Procurement

- Open to economic operators with access to EU market
- Apply as single tenderer or joint offer with partners (all must have access to EU market)
- Subcontracting is permitted (except sometimes for critical tasks)
- Subcontractors can be from countries which don't have access to EU market (unless that is required in the call)

Grants

- Open only to organisations on the Article 36 list
- Apply as single organisation or in consortium (all must be Article 36 organisations)
- Subcontracting is permitted for noncore tasks
- Subcontractors do not have to be on Article 36 list



How to apply?

Procurement

- Application either via email (<140 000€) or e-submission* (>140 000€)
- Evaluation carried out by EFSA staff, and feedback provided to all tenderers on their offer
- Evaluation Criteria
 - Exclusion criteria: Eligibility
 - Selection criteria: Experience; quality;
 price

Grants

- Application submitted in original, hard copy via post, or for some calls, e-submission*
- Evaluation carried out by EFSA staff and feedback provided to all applicants on their proposals
- Evaluation Criteria
 - Exclusion criteria: Eligibility
 - Selection criteria: Experience; quality



Contract / Gant award

Funding

The amount of the contract/grant is set out in the procurement/call documents

Contract negotiation

- Draft contract/grant agreement is published with call
- Negotiation of terms and conditions is not generally possible
- Any concerns about terms and conditions should be raised during the clarification stage before the submission of the offer/proposal
