**IV Health declaration**

I, the undersigned veterinarian do hereby certify that:

1. The above described shipment of pork and pork products is derived from animals that either are born and raised in Finland or are imported to Finland from a country recognized by the government of Korea as being eligible for the export of pork to Korea, and have been raised in Finland for no less than three months prior to slaughter.
2. The pork and pork products were produced under following animal health conditions:
  - a) there has been no occurrence in Finland
    - of Foot and Mouth Disease for a period of 1 year, of Vesicular Stomatitis, Swine Vesicular Disease (SVD) and Rinderpest for a period of two years and of African Swine Fever for a period of three years.
    - of Classical Swine Fever for a period of 1 year.

No vaccination has been conducted against aforementioned diseases.
  - b) the animals used for the production of the pork and pork products were born and raised on farms
    - where there were no outbreak of Brucellosis for a period of three years, of Anthrax for a period of two years and of Aujeszky's disease for a period of 12 months;
    - located in areas that are not subject to epidemic prevention measures related to the said diseases.
3. The pork and pork products were derived from swine slaughtered in an authorised slaughterhouse, approved by the Finnish Food Authority and operating under its supervision in terms of maintaining proper hygiene and have passed regular hygiene inspections. The facilities where the pork and pork products are handled are not located in areas infected by the diseases mentioned above. While work is being done on products to be exported to Korea handling of animals or products thereof, originated or passed through the country or region from which the import of artiodactyls and/or any products thereof is not permitted by the government of Korea, does not take place.
4. The pork and pork products were derived from swine which were subjected to ante-mortem and post-mortem veterinary inspection on the day of slaughter, and were found fit for human consumption. No abnormalities have been discovered in meat inspection regarding trichinellosis, cysticercosis and hydatidosis. No animals and/or products thereof not meeting at least the same level of sanitary conditions were handled in the facilities where slaughtering, cutting, processing, and packaging and storage is on-going to produce pork and pork products. Raw meat used for the production of pork products is eligible for export to Korea.
5. The pork and pork products meet the relevant regulations of Korea in terms of presence of residual materials (antimicrobials, agricultural pesticides, hormones, etc.), micro-organisms, irradiation, ionization and food additives (preservatives, meat tenderizers etc.) that may harm public health.
6. The pork and pork products have been handled in such a way that they have not been contaminated with any pathogens of contagious animal diseases. Packaging to wrap pork and pork products is hygienic and causes no harm to the human health. The pork, pork product or its packing bear the health mark including the approval number of the export establishment. The health mark, indicating that the meat has been treated in a manner not harmful to human health, has to be notified to the Korean government in advance.
